transactions. The next time you need to pay your bill, it will only take a couple of clicks. Additionally, making a payment with a credit or debit card will no longer require a fee.

Reporting a service issue is a snap on the SmartHub mobile app. You can also contact us for customer service requests or with questions.



## RISING ENERGY PRICES CAUSE INCREASE TO POWER COST ADJUSTMENT RIDER

Rapidly rising prices are affecting what consumers pay for gasoline, food, and even electricity. Unfortunately, NOVEC is not immune from the substantial increases occurring in the wholesale power markets. Because NOVEC's actual energy costs are outpacing its 2022 projections, the cooperative is modifying its power cost adjustment (PCA). Effective July 1, 2022, and for the remainder of 2022, the PCA applicable to residential and commercial accounts will be \$0.0095 per kilowatt hour (kWh). For example, a customer who uses a 1,000 kWh per month could expect to see a PCA charge of \$9.50 per month. NOVEC does not earn a margin (profit) on wholesale power it purchases on behalf of its customers. Instead, changes in wholesale purchased power costs are passed through at cost to customers using the PCA. NOVEC is a not-for-profit electric utility, with its rates and terms of service regulated by Virginia's State Corporation Commission. Learn more at novec.com/PCA.
